ORDER TO REVOKE LICENCE

On May 9, 2017, the Superintendent of Financial Services (“Superintendent”) issued a Notice of Proposal to revoke the insurance agent licence of Gregory F. Hilderman (“Mr. Hilderman”).

The Notice of Proposal was sent by regular mail and registered mail to Mr. Hilderman’s mailing address as it appears in the records of the Financial Services Commission of Ontario. Canada Post records indicate that the Notice was successfully delivered on May 12, 2017.

Mr. Hilderman had 15 days after service of the Notice to request a hearing before the Financial Services Tribunal (“Tribunal”) in accordance with subsection 407.1(3) of the *Insurance Act* (the “Act”).

On May 31, 2017, the Registrar of the Tribunal confirmed that no request for a hearing has been received from Mr. Hilderman.

Subsection 407.1(7) of the Act provides that the Superintendent may carry out the proposal to revoke a licence when no hearing has been requested.

ORDER

The insurance agent licence of Gregory F. Hilderman is hereby revoked.
